**Oct 8 The Factors Which Cause & Maintain Hypertension** — Prof Paul Korner, Director, Baker Medical Research Institute

Dr Biggs is a Sandoz Visiting Lecturer to the RMH. He will be speaking on bone marrow transplantation.

**Nov 5 The Transfer of Human Bone Grafts by Microvascular Techniques** — Mr Ian Taylor, Plastic Surgeon, RMH

Mr Taylor has been a pioneer in the techniques of microvascular grafting and earlier this year presented an extremely successful Huxterian Lecture to the Royal College of Surgeons in London.

**Nov 12 Ethical Issues in the Termination of Life** — Professor Peter Singer, Dept of Philosophy, Monash University

Professor Singer is widely known as an eloquent interpreter of complex philosophical issues and has recently taken a controversial stance on euthanasia and a number of other issues affecting the medical profession.

Nov 19 **Viral & Cellular Oncogenes** — Dr Ashley Dunn, Head of Molecular Biology Laboratory, Ludwig Institute, Melbourne

Dr Dunn, originally from Birmingham, did his doctorate at Cold Spring Harbor and has more recently worked at the European Molecular Biology Laboratory.

PROCEDURE FOR COURSES HELD UNDER THE AUSPICES OF A  
DEPARTMENT BUT ORGANISED BY AN OUTSIDE ORGANISATION

On the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Postgraduate Affairs, the Faculty Board, at its meeting 4/81, approved the following procedure for courses held under the auspices of a department but organised by an outside organisation :

(i) Reporting

- (a) Departments should submit details of the course, including dates and venue, to the Standing Committee on Postgraduate Affairs.
- (b) Departments should submit a brief report on the outcome of the course to the Standing Committee on Postgraduate Affairs.

(ii) Finance

Departments should ensure, in consultation with the sponsors, that all financial transactions involved in the running of such courses are dealt with by the outside organisation.

I should be grateful if you would bring this memorandum to the attention of staff members of your department who may be involved in such courses in the future.

Short Postgraduate Courses

At meeting 9/79, Council endorsed the proposal submitted by the faculty of Medicine to vary the provisions covering the approval for the running of all special short courses other than those conducted by the Centre for Continuing Education in the following manner :

- (a) Council delegate to its Finance Committee authority to approve the offering of special short courses;
- (b) the completed questionnaire be submitted to the Finance Manager not less than one month prior to the date by which a decision is required;
- (c) publicity to the course may be given following approval by Finance Committee; and
- (d) for special short courses in the faculty of Medicine, fees of less than \$8 per contact hour may be approved depending on the overall financial arrangements.

Accordingly, departments are required to adhere to the following procedure in the organization of any short postgraduate courses :

- (i) Details of the proposed course should be forwarded to the Faculty Secretary no later than two months prior to the date by which a decision is required. This would allow for the request to be forwarded to the Finance Manager for inclusion on the agenda of the next Finance Committee meeting, following approval by the Dean.

Departments should submit details of the course on the attached questionnaire. In the case of those courses where it is proposed that the fee to be charged be less than \$8 per contact hour, a statement outlining details of the overall financial arrangements should accompany the questionnaire.

- (ii) Departments should note that details of the course would also be transmitted by the Faculty Secretary to the Victorian Medical Postgraduate Foundation to ensure that there were no clashes with similar courses being offered elsewhere or courses aimed at the same audience. The Faculty Secretary would then report back to departments on any advice received from the Foundation.
- (iii) Following approval of the course by the Finance Committee, departments may publicize the course. Departments are reminded that the Victorian Medical Postgraduate Foundation has agreed to advise on advertisements and to organize the advertising of the course if required.

Short Postgraduate Courses (Cont'd)

Among the facilities available to the Foundation for advertising are the Newsletters of the Victorian Medical Postgraduate Foundation for Victoria-wide publicity and the Australian Postgraduate Federation in Medicine for Australia-wide publicity respectively. Both Newsletters are published on the first day of the following months: January, April, July and October. In both cases items for inclusion in the Newsletters need to be forwarded no later than one month prior to the date of publication. Departments intending to advertise in this way should note that it would therefore be necessary to submit an application for course approval to the Finance Committee at least three months prior to the publication date of the relevant Newsletter. For example, if a department wishes to advertise a course in the July edition of the Victorian Newsletter it would be necessary to submit the application form for Finance Committee approval to the Faculty Secretary by the end of February. This would allow for the normal processing of the application as outlined in point (1) and for an advertisement to be prepared and forwarded to the Foundation by the end of May.

- (iv) Fees from participants in courses should be paid into the separate account designated by the Finance Branch and expenses incurred by departments should be met from this account. Of the surplus, ten per cent would be transferred to a special fund for distribution at the discretion of the Vice-Chancellor, with the balance being returned to the department.



- (iii) Unless you are able to secure the services of a qualified technician from within your department, you should authorise me to arrange for the presence of a security guard/projectionist whose duties will start at 5.00 p.m. on Friday and all day Saturday. The cost of such service is \$20 per hour payable in cash to the person concerned and I need advance notification to enable me to arrange this to be done;
- (iv) We cannot guarantee parking facilities as I understand that the area is fairly heavily used by Bingo players from the Chevron Hotel.
